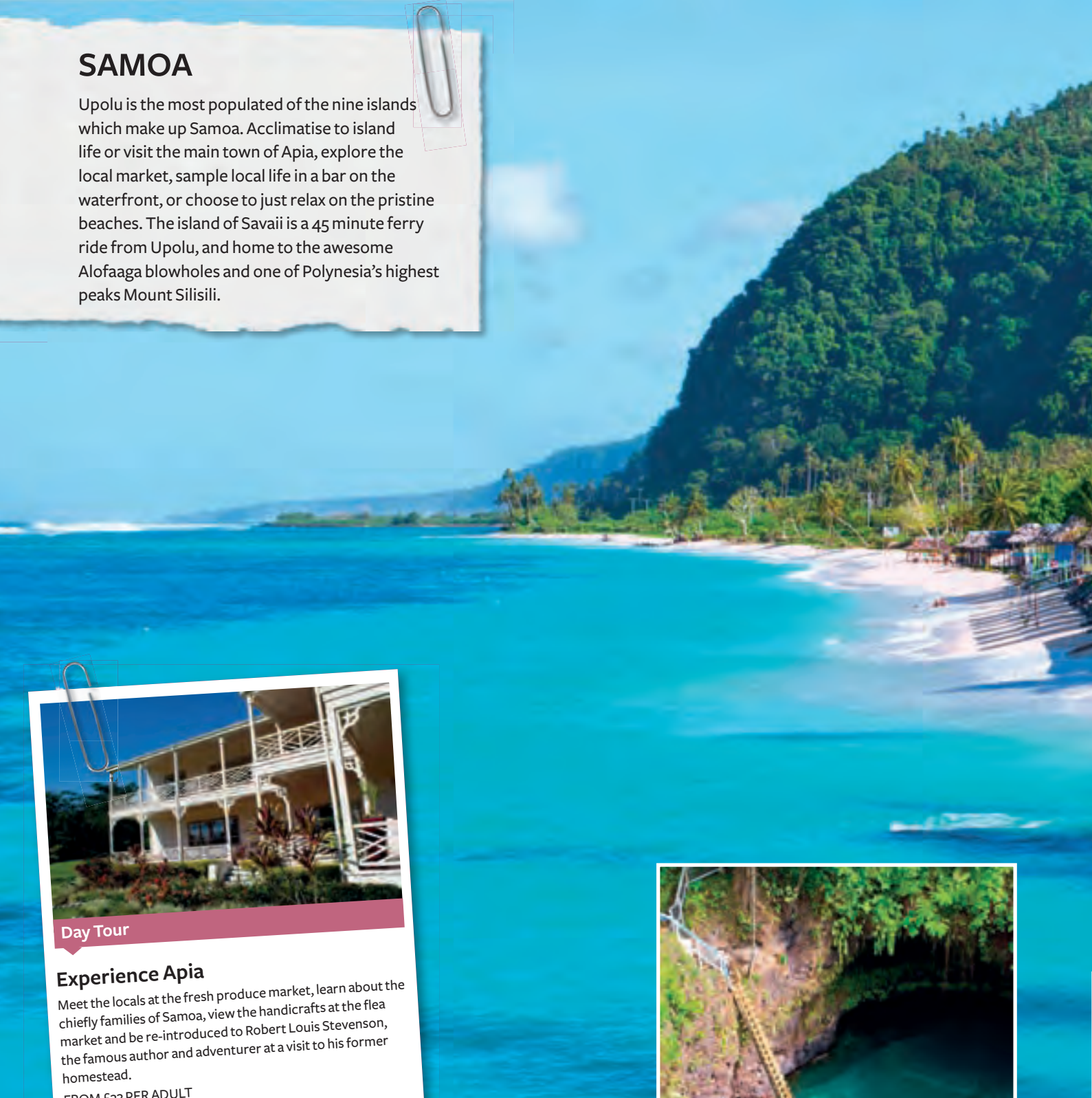


BORA BORA
